

Renewal of Baptism

Before any of us were able to confess our faith in God – God claimed us as children. The waters of the baptismal font remind us of this: Each of us – baptized or not – belongs to God. Our salvation does not depend on whether or not we are baptized.

Because we belong to God – it means that we are free to love. It means that we are to live in God's grace. Grace is free – but it comes with certain responsibilities; certain boundaries.

I want to ask you to clear your mind and answer these questions. Think about how much God loves you; think about what God wants for your life – what connections God desires for you to keep –and what disconnecting God is inviting you to do- so that you may have life abundantly.

Which commandment is the greatest of all?

You shall love the Lord your God with all of your heart, mind, soul –and you shall love your neighbor as yourself.

Do you renounce the ways of sin – the things that separate you from the love of God?

We renounce them.

Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Lord and Savior? **We do.**
